

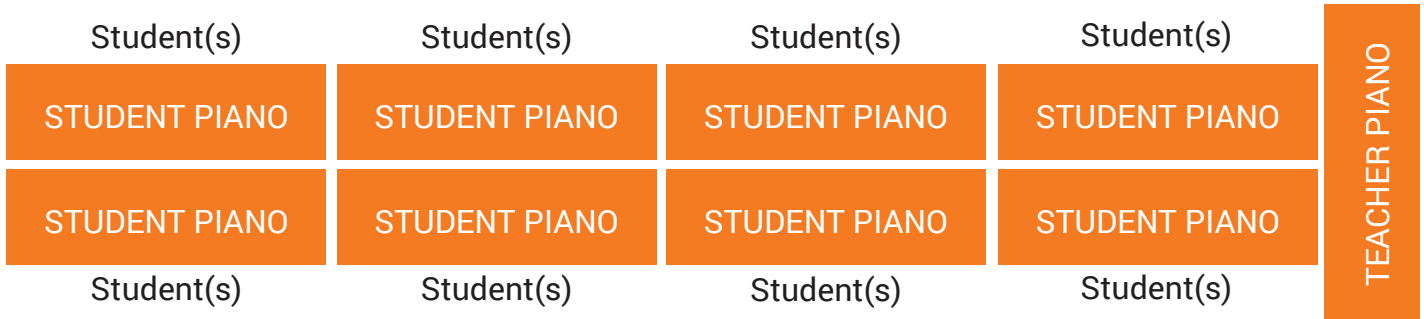
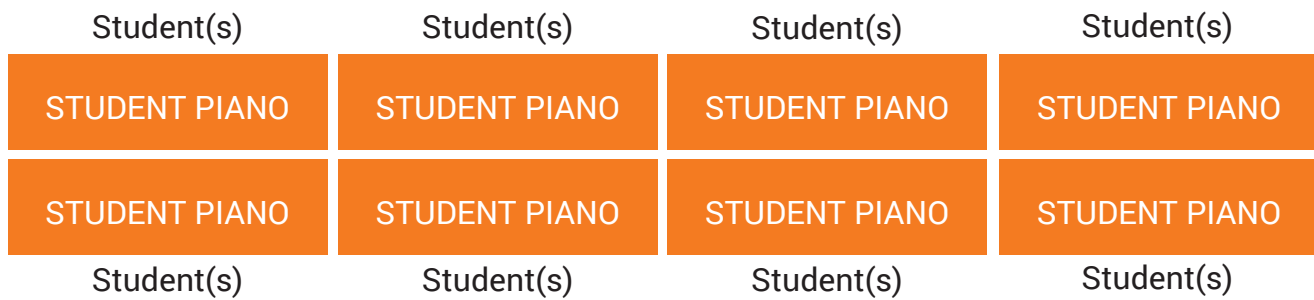

### BENEFITS

- Rows can be divided up into quartets.
- Played together, simple parts sound more complex.
- Encourages student leadership (ie - "Group Leader")
- Small groups build beneficial teamworking skills.
- Greater flexibility for unique learning styles/speeds.
- Increased feedback and peer motivation.
- Excellent cord management.

### CHALLENGES

- Students have to turn to face the teacher.
- Students have to turn to face visual displays.
- Small groups can easily distract adjacent groups.
- Teacher movement is more restricted.
